“Put Together a Natural Disaster Kit”

Safety Measures:

While it's important to protect your home and property, your life and comfort are even more important. So, long before you worry about trimming trees and boarding up windows, prepare a natural disaster kit for yourself.

“Your natural disaster kit should include enough items to last each person three to five days,” said Greg Simko, CEO at Life Gear (<http://www.lifegear.com>), which invents, manufactures and markets products with life-saving potential.

Simko recommended that you have a minimum of 1 gallon of water per person, per day. Also, have plenty of nonperishable food, preferably with a shelf life of five years so you don't have to remember to replenish it each year. In addition, keep the following:

- § 7-day supply of medications
- § Multipurpose tool

- § Whistle to signal for help
- § Sturdy flashlight with plenty of batteries
- § Hand-crank radio
- § First-aid kit
- § Blankets
- § Clean Clothes
- § Toiletries
- § Respirator mask

Preparedness is the answer;

STAY CALM and follow your emergency plans.
