Land & Water Conservation Fund Grant Available

Applications have become available from the Department for Local Government for a federal grant opportunity: The Land and Water Conservation Fund.

The Land & Water Conservation Fund (LWCF) provides federal grant funds to protect important natural areas, acquire land for outdoor recreation and to develop or renovate public outdoor recreation facilities such as campgrounds, picnic area, sports and playfields, swimming facilities, boating facilities, fishing facilities, trails, natural areas and passive parks. All recreational facilities that have received LWCF assistance must stay outdoor recreational for perpetuity. The minimum amount of funding requested is \$5,000 and the maximum grant amount is \$75,000. It is a matching reimbursement program. **The deadline to submit a LWCF application is April 28, 2017.**
