Rosine Community Internet Center Ribbon Cutting


Ohio County Judge Executive David Johnston (center) cuts the ribbon marking the official opening of the Rosine Community Internet Center on November 2.

The Community Internet Center is located with the Fire Station in the Rosine KY Community Park. A grant from USDA Rural Development funded the project which also brings high-speed service to the citizens of Rosine and Horse Branch in Ohio County.









GRADD along with other Area Development Districts (ADD) across Kentukcy partcipated in the Commonwealth of Kentucky Bowl, which was announced in September by Secretary of State Alison Lundergan Grimes.
