

SE4A Award Winners

44 AmeriCorps members worked at 32 sites across the region in the Senior Connections Program to improve nutrition, socialization, and disaster preparedness for seniors.

112,899 Home Delivered Meals served for 601 homebound clients and 85,185 Congregate Meals for 1,203 senior center clients.

586 clients assisted through Aging Case Management and 176 clients received Legal Assistance.

46 caregivers and 23 grandparents raising grandchildren assisted through the Family Caregiver and Kentucky Caregiver programs.

165 long-term care facility complaints investigated, 272 resident visitations, 42 surveys conducted, and 715 information/referral requests processed through the Ombudsman Program.


54 informational events hosted (reaching 1,214 individuals), and one-on-one benefits counseling for 807 clients through the State Health Insurance Assistance Program.


