I. <u>CALL TO ORDER</u>

Chair Johnny "Chic" Roberts called the meeting to order at 9:30 a.m.

II. NEW BUSINESS

1. <u>Providence Intermediary Relending Program Application</u>

Alex Kretzer, Local Government Analyst, explained the City of Providence has applied for funding through the Intermediary Relending Program in the amount of \$45,000. The purpose of this project is to replace and clean the filter media to improve the drinking water filtration for distribution. The total project cost is \$75,000, with \$30,000 being paid by the City of Providence.

Judge/Executive Steve Henry explained the water in Providence needs attention as customers complain of its bad taste and color but he questioned if the \$30,000 from the City of Providence has been secured as the City of Providence had approached the County for assistance in paying the \$30,000.

Mr. Kretzer stated the City had secured the funds but no resolution had been approved by the city council.

Joanna Shake suggested a resolution be presented at the next city council meeting committing \$30,000 to the project.

A motion was made by Curtis Dame and seconded by David Johnston to approve the Providence Intermediary Relending Program application pending a resolution is passed at the next city council meeting, dedicating funds from the City of Providence for the project. A vote was taken and the motion carried.
