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I. CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Steve Henry called the meeting to order at 9:04 a.m.

II. <u>NEW BUSINESS</u>

1. Yager Materials Grant Application

Chairman Steve Henry called upon Judge/Executive Charlie Castlen to explain the proposed Yager Materials Project.

Judge/Executive Castlen explained he had spoken to the Daviess County Fiscal Court (DCFC) with regards to being lead applicant on the Port Infrastructure Development Program (PIDP) grant application. After further review, DCFC has declined to be a lead applicant.

Further discussion ensued, which included the possibility of the Greater Owensboro Economic Development Corporation (GOEDC) as lead applicant.

Both Chairman Steve Henry and Vice Chairman Adam O'Nan expressed concern with GRADD being the lead applicant. Concerns included staff time spent on the project and would this open the door for future endeavors and how would those be decided. Joanna Shake reassured the Committee GRADD's cities and counties are priority and being a lead applicant would mean GRADD serves as the fiscal agent only.

Chairman Steve Henry suggested GRADD staff contact GOEDC to review the possibility of being lead applicant project sponsor. Should GOEDC decline being lead applicant, the GRADD Executive Committee would approve GRADD serving as lead applicant of the PIDP grant application.

A motion was made by Brad Schneider and seconded by Johnny Roberts to approve GRADD as lead applicant of the Yager Materials Port Infrastructure Development Program grant application, should GOEDC decline to sponsor the project. A vote was taken and the motion carried.

There being no further business to discuss, the meeting was adjourned.
