High-speed service has now been deployed and released in and around the Windward Heights

subdivision between Hawesville and Lewisport, and area previously unserved by ConnectGRADD. Upgrades have also begun on the Tunnel Hill water tank in Henderson County and high-speed services have been released in some areas near that site, plus new upgrades in the area near U.S. 41 just south of Henderson, bringing high-speed service to the Happy Acres neighborhood and areas nearby, between Henderson and Robards.

Further upgrades continue across the network to increase available speeds to as much as 12M and make high-definition video streaming available to rural customers.
