The GRADD family mourns the loss of board member Judge/Executive Jody Jenkins of Union County, who passed away on January 21. Judge Jenkins served as GRADD's Chairman of the Board in 2012 and 2013. Elected in 2007, Jenkins served as Union County Judge-Executive. He was modest and reserved about his accomplishments while in office. Jenkins was passionate about the needs of his community from infrastructure, emergency management, healthcare and senior citizens. Jenkins was also known for his support of coal mining and the economic growth it meant for Kentucky. Jenkins took

He also served as Kentucky Coal County Coalition Secretary/Treasurer, and was a Board Member for KCJEA.

Despite his political achievements, Jenkins was most proud of his daughters and family meant everything to him. His wife of 22 years and 3 daughters were his greatest treasures in life. Jenkins loved spending time with family and friends and engaging in witty conversation. He also enjoyed cooking and playing golf.
