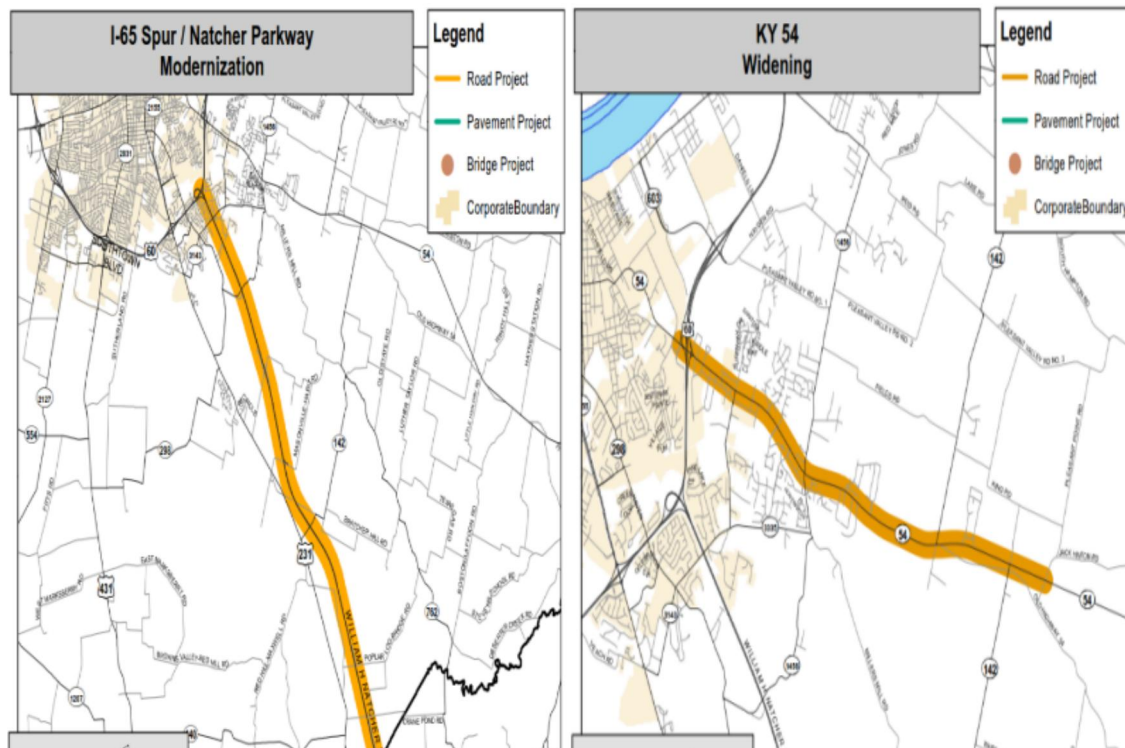


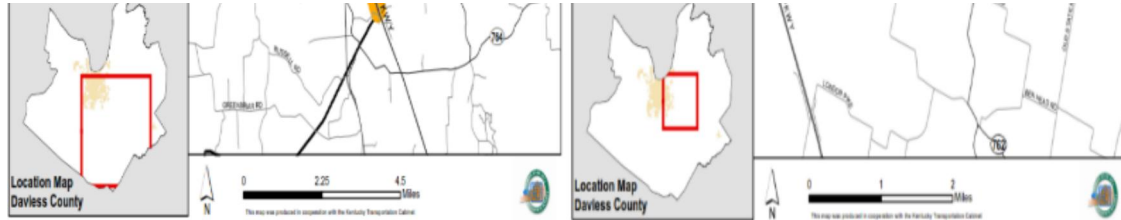




GRADD Staff Delivers Silver Bells Bags
