CITY OF HENDERSON: Business Expansion DRA Investment: \$314,965

DRA's investment will support extension of a water line to allow a local business to double its capacity and its workforce. About 40 new jobs will be created by the company, which has been producing a wide range of molecular weights and additive packages for nylon homopolymers and copolymers since 1957.



CITY OF STURGIS: Flood Protection DRA Investment: \$256,565 Total Investment: \$1.1 million

Sturgis needs to strengthen its flood wall to bolster flood protection for area residents and businesses. The 4-mile levee system was completed in 1968 and now has 10 deteriorating drainage pipes. DRA's investment will upgrade the pipes and provide continued safety for Sturgis' businesses and 669 families, who also should realize lower insurance premiums with the upgrade.
