I. CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Steve Henry called the meeting to order at 9:10 a.m. He welcomed everyone to the meeting.

II. CONSIDERATION OF MINUTES

Chairman Henry offered the minutes of the November 27, 2019, meeting of the GRADD Regional Transportation Committee for approval.

A motion was made by Mike Baker and seconded by Kevin Collignon to approve the minutes of the November 27, 2019, GRADD RTC meeting. A vote was taken and the motion carried.

III. OLD BUSINESS

A. RTC Membership

Chairman Henry asked for recommendations of individuals to fill the vacant committee representative positions of trucking, school transportation, and an interested citizen. Some suggestions were provided; he asked that any additional suggestions be sent to Gina Boaz.

IV. NEW BUSINESS

A. Interactive County Road Mapping System

J.T. Jones presented information concerning a project Webster County is undertaking to create on inventory of their road assets. Using GPS, they are collecting data points for things such as culverts, bridges, and road conditions. They are compiling this data into Google map software to create a comprehensive map of the locations and conditions of these assets.

B. I-69 Ohio River Bridge Crossing INFRA Grant Support Letter

Chairman Henry presented the committee with a letter to Secretary Elaine Chao, U.S. Department of Transportation in support of the KYTC's Infrastructure for Rebuilding America (INFRA) grant application seeking funding for Phase One of the I-69 Ohio River Crossing (ORX). The GRADD Board also submitted a letter of support to Secretary Chao.

C. 2020 GRADD Regional Transportation Planning Guide

Jennifer Alvey presented the 2020 GRADD Regional Transportation Committee Guide. She stated the guide is a resource that lists the role of the committee, information about developing Kentucky's Highway Plan, who to call, and transportation terms.

D. KY Recommended Highway Plan

Jennifer Alvey presented the KYTC FY 2020-2026 Recommended Six-Year Highway Plan for the GRADD region. She noted this was only the recommended plan, and the legislators believe there will be projects added to the list before it is finalized. She encouraged the committee to contact their legislators if they have any issues with the recommended plan.

E. FY 2020 Major Traffic Generators/Major Freight Users

Jennifer Alvey offered the FY 2020 Major Freight Users/Major Traffic Generators Update for the committee's review and suggestions. She noted this update will be submitted to KYTC and asked that any changes be submitted to Gina Boaz.

- Watson Ln bridge finish surface in spring
