I. CALL TO ORDER

Chair Judge Johnny Roberts called the meeting to order at 1:32 p.m. and noted there was a quorum.

II. OLD BUSINESS

A. <u>Secretary's Report</u>

Secretary Eric Hickman presented the minutes of the June 15, 2023, meeting of the GRADD Water Management Council for approval.

III. <u>NEW BUSINESS</u>

A. <u>Water Management Nominating Committee</u>

Chair Judge Johnny Roberts asked for volunteers to be on the Nominating Committee to nominate a slate of officers for next year. Mark Julian, Joe Schepers and Mayor Rhonda Moore Smith all volunteered.

B. <u>Consideration of Projects</u>

The following projects were presented for approval:

- 1. City of Island Sewer Generator Project
- 2. Daviess County Water District Hwy 81 Line Replacement
- 3. Henderson County Water District Lead Service Line Inventory

A motion was made by Eric Hickman and seconded by Gary Sheffer the above-mentioned projects be approved. A vote was taken and the motion carried.

C. Ranking Criteria Approval

Blake Edge presented the ranking criteria for approval.

A motion was made by Frankie Fulkerson and seconded by Joe Schepers to approve to ranking criteria. A vote was taken and the motion carried.

D. <u>2024 Intended Used Plan (IUP)</u> Review

Blake Edge provided the Council with a review of the IUP. Kentucky has 130 projects totaling \$800 million requested from the Clean Water SRF. GRADD has 13 projects totaling \$47,279,590. One project has been selected: the City of Sturgis Wastewater Treatment Plant Rehab at a cost of \$4,337,160. Kentucky has 379 projects totaling \$973.5 million requested from the Drinking Water SRF. GRADD has 33 projects totaling \$39,787,301. Five projects have been selected for LSL inventory: Ohio

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County Water District Lead Service Line Inventory for \$185,000; Owensboro Municipal Utilities Lead Service Line Inventory for \$1,000,000; and Cities of Fordsville, Sturgis and Uniontown Lead Service Line Inventory: KIA Technical Assistance.

E. 2025 Call for Projects

Blake Edge shared rankings are due to KIA by December 15, 2023. Mr. Edge will be conducting ranking meetings throughout November in all seven GRADD counties. Invites will be sent soon.

F. Regional Energy Resilience Project

Colie Smith, GRADD Regional Resiliency Coordinator, explained each utility will soon be contacted to complete a survey for the Regional Energy Resilience project taking place in the GRADD region. The survey is intended to gather detailed information on backup power capabilities for all critical facilities in the region. GRADD has gathered available information from the KIA portal and will send surveys to utilities within the week. Anyone with questions should contact Colie Smith for assistance.

G. GRADD Planning Update

Blake Edge shared Cheyton Pendley has departed GRADD to take a position at the Delta Regioal Authority, leaving an opening for the Infrastructure Planner Position. Dana Garrett, who has been with GRADD as a Community Development Planner since early 2023, has accepted the Infrastructure Planner position and will begin her new role on November 1st.
