Daviess County, Whitesville, Friendly Village, Lewisport, and Livermore get a visit from Commissioner Sandra Dunahoo

Commissioner Sandra Dunahoo from the Department for Local Government visited several GRADD communities on October 28th, and October 29th.

The reason for her visit was to announce several project funding announcements. They are as follows:

- City of Whitesville received \$541,250 in Community Development Block Grant funds for the Whitesville Wastewater Treatment Plant;
- City of Whitesville also received \$28,000 in Recreational Trail Grant funding for the repaving of the Whitesville Park Community Trail;
- Daviess County received \$75,000 for inclusive playground equipment;
- City of Lewisport received \$500,000 for the construction of a new 8,450 square foot public library; and
- City of Livermore received \$500,000 in Community Development Block Grant funds for the renovation of the fire station facility.
