Eligibility Criteria:

- Grandchild(ren) must be related by blood, marriage, or adoption (only one year of eligibility if adopted by grandparent).
- The child's parents must not reside in the home.
- Grandparent(s) must be Kentucky residents.
- Grandchild(ren) must be under 18 years old.
- Household income must be at or below 150% of the federal poverty level.
- Proof of custody and income from the past 12 months is required.
