The Green River Area Development District participates annually in the Long Term Care Ombudsman **Silver Bells** project for residents of personal care homes, collecting items to fill gift bags for delivery to residents living in personal care homes located in the seven-county area at Christmas time. Around 115 personal care residents receive the holiday gift bags through Silver Bells annually. This year, we would

like to provide gifts to approximately 150 residents in four personal care homes located in Daviess, Henderson, and McLean Counties. Many of the individuals residing in these personal care homes take part in the state supplementation program and only retain up to \$60 per month of personal spending money. The holiday bags provide welcome treats while allowing residents to use their resources on other needed items which are not provided by the facility. We invite individuals and organizations to contribute to the 2021 Silver Bells project and brighten the holiday season for a personal care resident! Any help to meet our goal would be appreciated!
